

About Iran

The Islamic Republic of Iran, with an area of approximately 1,600,000 square kilometers, is one of the largest countries in the Middle East and a crossroads connecting Central Asia, the Persian Gulf, and the Indian subcontinent. Iran, with a population of about 85 million, is considered a strategic country in the region due to its climatic diversity, natural resources, and geo-economic position. Throughout history, Iran has played a prominent role in shaping Asian trade, cultural, and civilizational pathways.

Iran's economy is based on vast energy resources, diverse mines, extensive agriculture, foundational industries, and interregional communication and transportation infrastructure. Access to the southern open waters, excellent geographical location, and the capabilities of skilled human resources make the country a dynamic center for international trade and industrial investment. Iran's cultural and historical diversity, combined with its growing industrial and commercial infrastructure, provides extensive opportunities for economic, exhibition, and tourism cooperation between Iran and other countries, positioning it as an influential hub for regional development.



About Fars Province

Fars Province, located in southwestern Iran, with an area of approximately 122,608 square kilometers, is the fourth largest province in the country and, with a population close to five million, the fourth most populous. Administratively, the province is divided into 37 counties, 97 districts, and 124 cities. It borders Isfahan and Yazd provinces to the north, Bushehr and Kohgiluyeh & Boyer-Ahmad to the west, Hormozgan to the south, and Kerman to the east.

Fars has historically held a strategic position in agriculture, industry, mining, construction, and tourism. The province's economy is based on extensive capacities such as mining industries, refineries, petrochemical industries, livestock, agriculture, and industrial towns. In recent decades, it has played an increasingly significant role in these fields. Its position along the short trade routes to Persian Gulf countries and its long-standing economic, cultural, and tourism interactions make Fars a key gateway between the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Persian Gulf countries, ensuring the development of international relations and strengthening economic indicators for both sides.

Iran's Capabilities, Capacities, and Potential in the Wood Industry and Related Industries

The Islamic Republic of Iran, as one of the prominent countries in the region in forestry, wood industries, and furniture, possesses extensive natural and industrial capacities. Rich wood resources in the northern, western, and southwestern regions, combined with a wide network of wood industry production units, have paved the way for remarkable growth in wood processing, furniture production, wooden products, and interior decoration.

In Iran, several thousand industrial units operate in various wood industry sectors, including the production of wooden products, machinery and equipment for the wood industry, particleboard, MDF, plywood, veneers, and hardware, playing a significant role in employment, exports, and the development of non-oil processing industries. Access to raw materials, the development of processing units, and the use of new technologies in design, machining, and production line automation have turned Iran into a dynamic hub for the wood industry in the region. Investment in furniture, cabinet making, veneer work, and interior decoration, alongside attention to high-quality raw materials production, has created significant momentum in both domestic and export markets. Iran's geographical advantage in access to neighboring markets and skilled human resources provides a golden opportunity for sustainable development of this industry.

Fars Province's Capabilities, Capacities, and Potential in the Wood Industry and Related Industries

Fars Province, with extensive industrial infrastructure, skilled human resources, strategic geographical location, and a large consumer market, is one of the key regions in the country in the field of wood industry and related industries. The presence of numerous active production units in the fields of wooden products, cabinetry, office and home furniture, hardware, wooden doors and windows, and MDF has made the province a hub for the growth of wood industries in southern Iran.

The province's capacity to supply raw materials through an efficient logistics network and access to southern ports, alongside equipped industrial towns and special economic zones, has enabled the industrial cycle related to wood—from supply to processing and final production—to take place within the region. Extensive activity of workshops and factories producing processed wood products, MDF, veneers, and decorative items, alongside the presence of national brands in machinery and hardware, has elevated Fars' position in regional trade and the export of processed goods. Its proximity to construction and interior decoration industries, active participation of architects and decorators, and growing demand for wooden products in construction projects give the province a special role in the wood industry value chain of Iran, making it one of the influential hubs in southern Iran.






